## What is RAPT?

The **Rippleton Association of Parents and Teachers** (School Council) is more commonly known as RAPT. RAPT is a group of parent volunteers who work in collaboration with school administrators, staff and the Toronto District School Board (TDSB) “to improve student achievement and enhance the accountability of the education system to parents (Reg. 612/2.1) through active parent engagement”.

The **purpose** of the School Council is to:

- Promote learning about the school's educational program & student achievement and discuss & advise on matters of interest or concern to parents and students.
- Engage, enhance & promote collaboration between parents, students, the school, and the community.
- Support & sponsor school committees, fundraising activities/events and cultural, arts, social & athletic activities for students.

RAPT organizes fundraisers and events for the school which help to foster a sense of community. Through our fundraising efforts we can support and enrich student learning and help create an optimal educational environment for our children. We allocate fundraised monies according to established spending priorities and to benefit the school's overall operations.
